The Baltimore City Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #3 has been informed by the family of Fallen Hero Police Officer James D. Halcomb that John Earl Williams who was convicted of murdering Officer Halcomb is scheduled to appear for a parole hearing in June 2008. Angie Halcomb, widow of Police Officer Halcomb was notified of this hearing by the Maryland Parole Commission

Officer Halcomb was viciously gunned down on April 16, 1976 and 5 additional Police Officers were shot by John Earl Williams during the same incident.

The Baltimore City Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #3 is adamantly OPPOSING THE RELEASE OF THIS CONVICTED COP KILLER AND WE ARE ASKING FOR YOUR HELP IN THIS ENDEAVOR.

Attached you will find a copy of the letter that the Baltimore City Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #3 has composed to address our adversity regarding the possibility of convicted cop killer John Earl Williams being granted parole through the State of Maryland Parole Commission.
